- **Mr. Martin** – Chamber Choir is going to Lake Ozarks to perform at a State Level-MMEA in January. This is the first time in our school's history FZS has received this honor. Choir Boosters is paying for their own a charter bus. Approximately 675 music educator attendees will be at the concert, Choir asking for Boosters to pay for a program, 800 copies, 8 page, color printing (similar to graduation handout) that has school info in it, bios, info on 7 songs It has a foil stamp on the program and the printer has our district die cut. They will cost \$1,674.01. Yvette Wiemann made a motion and Kathy Goode seconded the motion. All were in favor, no opposition.
- **Mr. Manes** - Theater is asking for LED lights, we currently have conventional lighting, LED takes less power, these will also allow for more colors (light). They are asking for 12 fixtures, safety cables, pipe clamps, DMX cables that costs \$7,445.55. Current conventional lights are from the year 2002. Any income that the district makes for renting out the facility they get to keep. We would like Mr. Manes and Mr. Rapp to approach the district to try to help cover some of the cost since the district will benefit with reduced savings (bulbs, resale of old lights, electricity, etc.). In addition, discussion took place regarding asking Progress South, Emge, and South Middle for some funds to assist in the cost. Melinda Bostic motioned and Brandy Keffer seconded the motion for \$3,722.50 will be committed to pay to these lights if District will pay the other half. This motion passed.
